Ubuntu's latest offering is fully integrated with Launchpad, an infrastructure that provides easy translation, patch sharing, bug tracking, and technical support. This version of Ubuntu also includes editable Gnome menus and an enhanced tool for installing new applications.

The Linux 2.6.12 kernel included with Breezy Badger comes with many updated drivers. Ubuntu 5.10 offers more Bluetooth, better support for printers,

enhanced power management features, and better compatibility with more audio devices. You'll also find better support for thin client systems, as well as improved clustering features.
