Mandrake 9.0 Updates

Updates for both security and non-functional packages, are essential for a smooth-running system. MandrakeSoft recommends that all users upgrade to the packages issued by any advisory to prevent problems with your system and unauthorized intrusion or denial of service attacks.

Please note: While MandrakeSoft supports a large number of Mandrake Linux distributions, not all are supported. If you are currently using an unsupported distribution, please upgrade to a more recent version to ensure you continue to obtain timely updates.

Galeon 1.3.3

Galeon is a GNOME Web browser based on gecko (the Mozilla rendering engine). It's fast, it has a light interface, and it is fully standards-compliant.

Galeon aims to utilize the simplest interface possible for a browser. Keep in mind that simple does not necessarily mean less powerful.

Gnomemeeting 0.96.1

GnomeMeeting is an H.323 compatible video conferencing and Voice over IP telephony application that lets you to make either audio and/or video calls to other users. It supports all modern video conferencing features, such as registering to an ILS directory, gatekeeper support, making multi-user conference calls using an external MCU, using modern Quicknet telephony cards, and making PC-to-phone calls.

Camino 0.7

So the Mac OS X readers are not left out we have included the new Camino (formerly Chimera) 0.7 browser. Along with the new name, Camino has a new history sidebar and a new text encoding menu.

abcde 2.1

Abcde is a front-end command-line utility (actually, a shell script) that grabs tracks off a CD, encodes them to ogg or mp3 format, and tags them, all in one go.

emelfm 0.92

emelFM is a file manager that implements the popular two-pane design. It features a simple GTK+ interface, with a scheme for flexible filetypes, and a built-in command line for executing commands without opening an xterm.

Kernel IPsec

Kernel IPsec is a means of embedding security into both IPv4 and IPv6.

IPsec can be deployed to protect data going between two hosts, between a host and a router / firewall, or between two routers / firewalls. It also gives fine grained control as to how the security is implemented – what services to use where, what combination, and what algorithms to use.

Zebra 0.93

GNU Zebra manages TCP/IP based routing protocols. It supports BGP-4 protocol as well as RIPv1, RIPv2 and OSPFv2.

Zebra has a process for each protocol. Zebra uses multithread technology. However it can be run under non-multithread supported UNIX kernels. Each module can be upgraded independently of the others.

Zebra is intended to be used as a Route Server and a Route Reflector.

Splint 3.0.16

Splint is a tool for statically checking C programs for security vulnerabilities and coding mistakes. With minimal effort, Splint can be used as a better lint.
