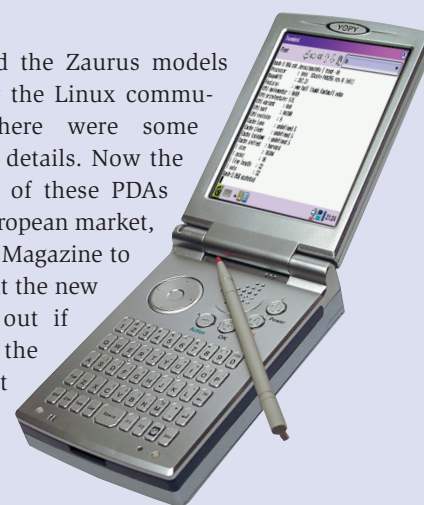

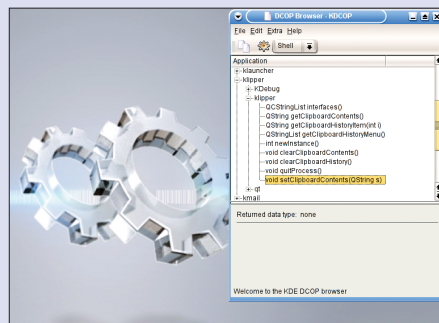

KDE desktop, and so remove much of the tedious work that you otherwise hate to do, or as is more likely the case, put off for another day.



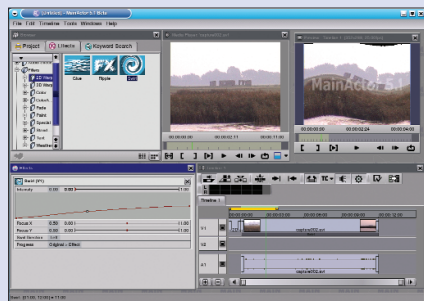
### 58 Admin Workshop
